Lochmaben Church, Phases 1 & 2

Client: Lochmaben Church Committee
& Fabric Convenor

Scope of the Project

Phase 1 - Making and fitting of eight gothic windows to replace existing
Phase 2 - Making and fitting two further windows with complex profiles (glazed on site with coloured glass)

Services Provided

Detailed survey and discussion with client established that the original windows could not be repaired to the required standard. Working closely with the fabric convenor (a retired architect with many years experience of detailing traditional joinery), some details of the windows were revised to avoid the problems that had led to the decay of the originals.

Sashworks made and fitted a total of ten large windows using a variety of traditional construction techniques
